Introduction.

What is this report about? Well, let's start with what it is NOT. *It's NOT about wholesale buying, buyer's clubs, coupons, liquidations or Internet comparison shopping.* It IS about a little known, 100% free, underground technique that is available to anyone who happens to know about it. We'll get to this in a moment, but be warned that this lets you buy almost anything more cheaply than any of the methods listed above, sometimes for as little a \$.01...*that's right one penny!!!*

Who are this report and the free webtool for? They're for bargain hunters of all kinds. They're absolutely perfect for...

Now, let's get on with the report...

The Secret.

In the Introduction, we told you what this underground technique is not. Now we'll tell you what it is. The secret is simply a technique, with the help of our 100% free webtool, of legally stealing eBay merchandise right out from under the sellers. With our webtool, you just bid the auction minimum, which is often \$.01. eBay sellers will unhappily take your penny, package up your item and ship it out to you.

But if you bid the minimum won't you just get outbid? No! And here's why...other buyers won't even see the auction!

At the time of this writing, there are over 30,000,000 auctions live on eBay. Many of them are listed by sophisticated professional sellers. Many are listed by people cleaning out their garage. Many are brand new products, sent directly from a wholesale dropshipper's warehouse. Many are expensive used items such as jewelry or collectors items. Many are just used pieces of junk. What do they all have in common? All the auction ads were written by humans. And, as we all know, humans make mistakes!

The kind of mistakes I'm talking about are simple typos...that's right, just misspellings...but these particular typos are worth big bucks!

Here's an example. Imagine that you want to buy a Stratocaster guitar. You fire up your browser, click to eBay and search for "stratocaster". 3,667 listings come up. Guess what? Everyone else who is looking for a Stratocaster just did the same search, and you're going to have to bid against them for your new guitar.

But if you're using our webtool, you fire that up instead. Then you enter in "stratocaster". But instead of pulling up the same results, it pulls up just 24. They all list things like "straticasters", "stratovasters" and "startcoasters". Some of those 24 are for things like picks and strings, but one guitar's bidding starts at \$0.99 with NO BIDS! Who wouldn't jump on that?

Now, unless you either used our webtool or sat trying random misspellings or went through every single one of the 93,920 guitar listings, you'd probably never even see these...and no one else will either! That means you're probably the only bidder!

I hope you're beginning to understand how powerful this is.

But how many of these valuable typos can there really be? Well out of 30,000,000 auctions, there are literally hundreds of thousands of these valuable little typos out there at any time. If you don't believe me, finish reading this report and fire up the webtool linked at the back of this report. Just enter in a few random brand names or products and you'll see for yourself.

That's really all there is to it. But keep reading. There are a number of tips that we'll provide next to help ensure you get the very best deals possible with the help of our free webtool.

How to Use the Free PenniesOnTheDollar Webtool.

Our 100% free webtool is very simple to use. In fact, it works just like eBay's own search functionality.

Step 1.

Open your web browser, and navigate to:

Nothing needs to be installed on your system. Heck, there's not even a registration.

Step 2.

Enter your search terms or keywords in the box where it says "Item". Then click the "Search" button and wait for results. That's it! When you find an item you're interested in just click on it and you'll be taken to eBay's page.

Getting the Most from PenniesOnTheDollar.

While the tool is extremely simple to use, there are some tricks to getting the most out of it.

Have Patience.

Whether you're using our free webtool or not, this is sound advice for any eBay buyer. If you've spent any time at all on eBay, you've probably seen people get caught up in the excitement of bidding. The next thing they know, they've paid twice as much for something as they intended, often more than they could have bought it for at the store down the street! Bargain hunting requires patience.

Now, we already discussed how many typos there are on eBay. However, there won't be typos for every single item at every single moment. Be patient. Saving a few hundred dollars on a new car, or saving \$50 on a pristine first edition by your favorite author, or getting an Alex Rodriguez mint rookie card for \$.99 will be worth it.

TIP - Most auctions are 7 days so when you're looking for a particular item, simply fire up PenniesOnTheDollar and search every 7 days. If you're a collector or reseller and are continuously looking for a number of items, keep them in a spreadsheet or text file and systematically search for each item every 7 days.

Plan In Advance.

This is my absolute dead favorite trick to use with the PenniesOnTheDollar webtool because it offers the opportunity to make everyone I love so happy!

Closely related to having patience is planning your purchases in advance. If there are things you buy every year, such as birthday gifts, Christmas gifts, or anniversary gifts, make a list of them.

Next think about what that person would really, really like to get. It may be something they've always wanted but could never afford or that YOU could never afford to give them. What's that one elusive addition to their collection? What are their hobbies? What are their dreams? Put those keywords or search terms in your spreadsheet.

Then you simply search for them every 7 days! This won't take you more than 15 minutes or so once a week. But it will allow you to give everyone on your list an absolutely incredible gift, sometimes worth thousands of dollars, without breaking your budget.

Think about this. Assume you buy 50 gifts each year. You can spend \$50 on each gift for a total of \$2,500 and everyone gets a gift worth \$50. Or you can use PenniesOnTheDollar to buy each person a gift worth \$100-\$1,000 while only spending \$50 (if the starting bids were all \$1.00)!

Do this. You'll be glad you did.

Wait to Bid.

Don't get too excited and jump in and bid on an item the second you see it. There are a couple of reasons for this.

First, bidding brings attention to items from other bidders. Depending on how viewers sort items, unbid items remain at the bottom of the list. Also, instead of a blank in the "current price" field, bidding will put a number there which makes the listing stand out more.

Second, it brings attention from the seller. If a seller sees a bid of \$.01 is about to win an expensive item they may decide to cancel the auction, or they may realize their mistake and fix the typo bringing other bids. However, eBay makes it much harder to cancel a sale once the auction is over.

We recommend waiting until about one minute before the auction is set to end. Then simply put in a lowball bid. If someone else did the same thing and outbids you, don't worry about it. Another misspelled item will come along soon.

TIP – Many people use “sniper” software, which will automatically place your bids for you at the last minute. We recommend BayGenie for this. It’s by far the very best sniping software available and does a great job of managing all the auctions you’re interested in. You can download your own copy of the Free version by [CLICKING HERE](#). Upgrading to the Pro version is \$19.95. This is not required but does offer some additional functionality.

CAUTION! – NEVER use any web-based sniping service. To use these, you must provide them with your eBay account information. I’ve heard too many horror stories about these guys. No matter what they tell you, just don’t do it! Stick with software that resides on your own system so you have control.

Earning Quick Cash.

You can also use PenniesOnTheDollar to make some quick cash reselling products on eBay. Just look through the various lists of hot sellers that are available on eBay and various other places around the web. Then put together a list of those items, and search for them every 7 days. Once you’ve bought an item, you can immediately turn around and *relist it right there on eBay!*

TIP – To maximize your profits, use the same techniques eBay’s Powersellers use. There are a number of both free and paid guides available to teach new eBay sellers the ropes. I honestly haven’t looked at any of the newer ones, but have heard good things about eBay Fortune from people I trust. If you want to wait until you’ve made a few bucks before purchasing something like that, just do a Google search for “free ebay ebook”.

Final Thoughts.

Well, that brings us to the end of our report. That's all there is to it. I hope you understand just how simple yet valuable this technique is with our free webtool. And I hope you aren't one of the many who will just leave this report sitting unused on your hard drive. Don't think for a minute that this tool must be worthless just because it's free.
